

Health and Safety Policy

Waikato Boat Expo is committed to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy environment for all members, assistants and attendees at the Boat Expo and to providing the necessary information and supervision needed to achieve this.



The Waikato Boat Expo will take responsibility for health and safety procedures, however, members, volunteers and the public need to be aware of their responsibilities and comply with the WBE health and safety policy.

Each member/ volunteer/ Exhibitor is encouraged to play a vital and responsible role in maintaining a safe and healthy workplace through:

- Being involved in the managing the show, and attending briefings.
- Sticking to correct procedures and equipment.
- Wearing protective clothing and equipment as and when required.
- Reporting any incident as soon as possible.
- Ensuring all accidents and incidents are reported.
- Helping other members / volunteers/ exhibitors and visitors to the Boat Expo understand the right safety procedures and why they exist.
- Telling Boat Show Management immediately of any health and safety concerns.
- Keeping the Boat Show Exhibition place tidy to minimize the risk of any trips and falls.
